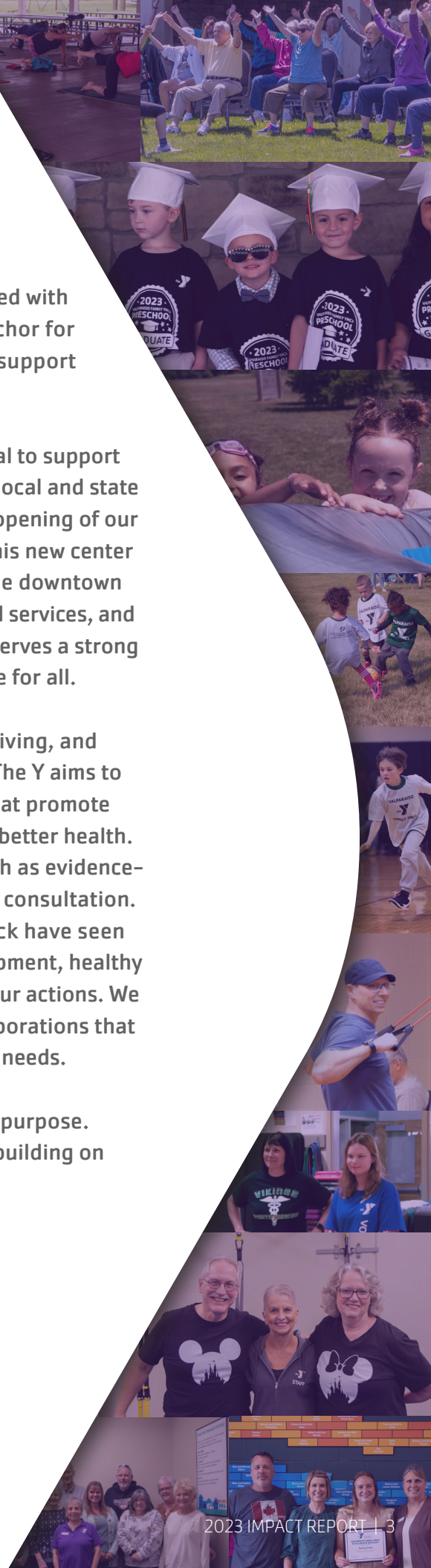

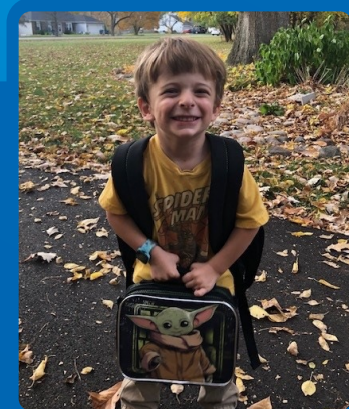
WE DEVELOP
