OUR STAFF

Our lead teachers in each classroom have either their CDA or a degree in Early Childhood Education, as well as experience teaching preschool age children.

All teaching staff undergo 12 hours of continued education training every year along with background checks and fingerprints, per state guidelines. All of our highly qualified staff are CPR & First Aid Certified and receive extensive hours of training and professional development.

CHILD CENTERED FOCUS

Our goal is to create a fun and safe environment that fosters children's learning through activities that teach the Y's core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility. To complement the traditional classroom experience, Y kids develop self-control and a sense of purpose through activities such as swimming, community field trips, fitness, sports skills, and cooking and nutrition lessons.

THE Y IS A HEPA FACILITY

Children engage in healthy eating and physical activity 30-60 minutes/day. Fresh fruits, vegetables and whole grain snacks are provided. Children are encouraged to make healthy choices both at the YMCA and at home.

TODDLER CARE

Ages 2-3

We nurture each child and build strong relationships with parents. Parents will receive frequent updates on their child's progress.

PRESCHOOL

Ages 3-5

Preschool programs provide students with the foundation of learning to prepare them for future success. Children engage in language arts, handwriting, math concepts, science, social and emotional awareness, music, visual arts, and large and small muscle development. Progress and growth is frequently assessed and communicated with parents.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN
